Due to an Epinephrine 1:10000 prefilled syringe shortage, we wanted to remind our system participants how to dilute anaphylaxis dose epinephrine to cardiac dose epinephrine.

- 1. If 1:10000 epinephrine is unavailable, retrieve epinephrine 1:000 from your drug box/storage.
- 2. If the epinephrine 1:1000 is in a glass ampule, use a filtered needle.
- 3. If the epinephrine 1:1000 is in a vial, use a traditional needle.
- 4. Obtain a 10mL prefilled normal saline syringe.
- 5. Expel 1mL of normal saline from the prefilled syringe.
- 6. Attach the appropriate needle to the normal saline prefilled syringe and draw the 1mL of 1:1000 epinephrine.
- 7. When all the epinephrine has been drawn from the ampule/vial, remove the needle and properly dispose of it.
- 8. Gently turn the syringe up and down to mix the solution.
- 9. Attach the Luer tip of the syringe to the administration set, saline lock, or IO hub.
- 10. Properly administer the 10mL of 1:10000 epinephrine.
